War Dogs of the Pacific

There will be a short movie at the November meeting that was recently premiered at the Doberman Pinscher Club of America National Specialty. It is especially important in this time of war, terror, and our on-going fight against animal rights activists. The public must understand the positive and life-saving contributions that our dogs make to society.

Its 1942 somewhere in the pacific: Deadly ambushes by entrenched Japanese in the thick jungles take a heavy toll on American troops. Marine commanders were willing to try anything, including using dogs to sniff out the hidden enemy. But even with their superior senses, nobody anticipated just how effective they would be.

'War dogs of the Pacific', directed by Harris Done, tells the incredible story of the marine dog platoons of World War II. It's a heart-warming exploration of the unique bond that formed between the young marines and their dogs-they teamed up to perform dangerous missions. But their success at finding the hidden enemy saved countless lives in the Pacific. These dogs proved themselves worthy of the title, "Man's best friend."

Filled with tales of devotion, bravery and sacrifice, the story is told by the dog handlers themselves. The film follows the men and their dogs through training and into combat. From the invasion of Guam to operations on Saipan, Okinawa, and Iwo Jima, the film is filled with exciting historical footage and many never before seen photos.

Highlights from the October 2008 meeting of the AKC Board of Directors

• The Board voted to accept the report of the Group Realignment Committee at the same time expressing its appreciation to the committee for the work that went into it. The report, along with the procedure for submitting comments, are included in the minutes of the October meeting.

• The Board voted to amend its policy in order to facilitate the use of the online individual registration of coowned dogs. Details are included in the minutes of the October meeting.

• Numerous amendments to the Obedience Regulations, as recommended by the Obedience Advisory Committee, were approved. The amendments, with the effective dates, are included in the minutes of the October meeting.

• Effective immediately, the AKC Discipline Guidelines for registration were amended pertaining to the refusal to consent to an inspection when requested:

Registration Violations (All Privileges)

Refusing to produce dogs or records *		
Mitigated	Standard	Aggravated
6 months/\$500	5 yr†/\$1000	Life†/\$3000

† (If reinstated, must start with a new colony, or in lieu thereof, bring back dogs from the old colony for which a DNA profile is recorded with the AKC and is positively identified via microchip or tattoo.)

*Reinstatement is contingent on passing an AKC inspection.

Rabies Tags Required

In Greenville City

Your rabies tag on your dog serves as your registration with the City of Greenville. Rabies tags must be current, obtained from a licensed veterinarian and displayed on your dog at all times.

Pear Flan Recipe

Sharon Spiegel

Sharon Spiegel has had a few requests for her Pear Flan recipe and wanted to share it with the club members. She said, "It is very easy to make and would make a wonderful Thanksgiving Dinner dessert."



1 Unbaked pie crust Dash salt 4 pears Ground cinnamon 1 egg Confectioners' sugar 3/4 cup sugar 1/4 cup dairy sour cream 1/4 teaspoon vanilla

GARNISH:

Fresh strawberries, sliced Dollop of whipped cream

Prepare pie crust in pan. Refrigerate.

Preheat oven to 450-degrees.

Peel, core, and quarter pears. Cut pears into 1/8-inch slices. Arrange on pie crust in a pinwheel fashion.

Beat together egg, sugar, sour cream, vanilla, and salt; pour over pear slices. Sprinkle with cinnamon.

Bake 10 minutes.

Reduce oven temperature to 375-degrees; bake 30 minutes or until knife inserted near center of flan comes out clean.

Remove from oven. Sprinkle with Confectioners' sugar. Garnish with strawberry slices around outer edge of flan and a dollop of whipped cream in the center. Serve warm or cold. Makes 10 servings.
